

### **'Music for the Homeless Camping Advise plus rules & regs;**

Set up times for camping open at 9am and closes at 4pm, no campers will be allowed to set up after 4pm (please note that if you need your car to drop your tent off on the site then you must be on site before gates open at 12-30pm)

Campers need to be off site by 11am on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> June

Due to safety measures campers cars must be parked in the secured staff car park.

All campers will be issued a wristband at the entrance gates

All campers must have a festival ticket (except under 8's who are free)

Campers are responsible for their possessions; The organisers take no responsibility for any loss or damage whilst on site. However, there will be a supervised area where you can leave your sleeping bags.

Children must be accompanied and supervised by parents at all times

Campers must commit to try to raise a minimum of £50 through our 'just giving' page or sponsorship form. Proof of this will need to be shown to gain entrance to the campsite

No running water is on site so bring your own bottled water, tea, coffee and food and drink available on site.

The Breakfast unit will be open from 7am until 10-30am

### **Camping Rules and Regs;**

No pets

No air horns

No fireworks, flares, smoke bombs or Chinese lanterns

No Drones

All children must be accompanied by their parents

No Gas cylinders of any size

Cars to be left in the car park

No BBQ's or fires

No Glass on site

No Sharps or items that could be used as a weapon

No Drugs or legal highs

A full bag and tent search will take place prior to camping set up

No loud music to be played

No Alcohol to be brought on site

No tents larger than 5 berth allowed (tent pitches are £25 for 2 adults, a maximum of 3 children are included in the fee)

Food is allowed on site but we also have food stalls serving breakfasts with Vegetarian options.

Please use the waste bins provided or take away your waste

**Important:**

If you fail to reach this target you will not be allocated a wristband to sleep out and your deposit and any monies raised will be donated directly to the CAP (Charity Reg No 1064818). You will still be able to attend the music event.

Should one or more artists cancel, the event will go ahead as normal. Refunds will not be given in these circumstances.

I accept it is my responsibility to bring appropriate items such as: Sleeping Bag, Warm Clothing waterproof cover etc if I am not bringing a tent.

In the extreme unlikelihood of cancellation of 'Music for the Homeless' all fundraising and any/all subsequent donations for tent pitches are non-refundable and will go to The Cathedral Archer Project (CAP) (Charity Reg No 1064818), however, we will endeavour re-arrange the event in a reasonable timeframe but this cannot be guaranteed.
